Guidelines for Photographers

- 1. Photos can only be taken before the ceremony, during the procession of the Bridal party and Bride, during the exchange of vows, and as the couple leave the Church. *One-half hour (30 mins.) is allotted for photography after the wedding.*
- 2. Flash cannot be used during the liturgy.
- 3. The steps going up to the altar and the altar area are strictly <u>forbidden</u> territory.
- 4. Photographers will stay on one side of the front pew. You must not be walking from side to side in the sanctuary. *This is distracting*.
- 5. You must handle all photography in a **professional manner**.
- 6. Your movements must be discreet as to not distract from the sacredness of the liturgy. *Please remember this is not just a ceremony it is a Sacrament.*
- 7. Under no circumstances are you to **stop** the procession or any part of the Mass/Ceremony for photography.
- 8. If you fail to follow any of the above rules, it will result in your company not being welcomed into Saint Anthony Church for future photography.
