

**Maintenance Director** Andrew Massagee 954-445-8278 Parish Religious Education Program (PREP): Sessions for boys and girls in kindergarten (5 yrs. By 9/1), 1st through 6th grade as well as junior/senior high school sacrament preparation on Sundays will begin on September 20, 2020, at 10:15 a.m. until 11:15 a.m. As this PREP year begins sessions will be accessing the Virtual Distance Learning model. This will be revisited as the situations change with the hope of returning to the classrooms when it will be safe and healthy for everyone.

Preparation for the Sacraments of First Reconciliation (confession/penance) and/or Confirmation involve a minimum of two years in preparation. The wisdom in this guideline is to provide a foundation in faith the first year with a focus on immediate preparation the next.

Inquiring and returning families will receive a packet of information in the mail. All questions and concerns are important!
